BY THE COMMISSION:

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Railroad Commission of the State of California finding after further consideration of the evidence in this proceeding and for good cause that the rate for electric cooking service heretofore fixed by Decision 7824 in Application 5585 should be modified as hereinafter set forth, and that the rate herein set forth is just and reasonable,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Schedule No. C-1 as set forth in Decision No. 7824 be and the same is hereby modified to read as follows:

SCHEDULE C-1

(Cancel G.W.P.Co. former schedules 301 and 302.)

DOMESTIC COOKING AND HEATING SERVICE  
AND COMBINATION DOMESTIC SERVICE:

Applicable to domestic heating and cooking service and to domestic combination lighting, heating and cooking service.

TERRITORY:

Applicable to entire Great Western Power Company's system.

RATE:

a. Heating and Cooking Service:

First 180 k.w.h. per meter per month 3.5¢ per k.w.h.  
All over 180 " " " " " 2¢ " "

b. Combination Lighting, Cooking and Heating Service:  
(Applicable only to residences, flats and apartments of eight or less rooms.)

First 30 k.w.h. per meter per month (X) per k.w.h.  
Next 150 " " " " " 3.5¢ " "  
All over 180 " " " " " 2¢ " "

(X) Top Block of Residence Lighting Rate Applicable.

MINIMUM CHARGE:

75¢ per kilowatt of active connected load per month  
but not less than \$3.00 per month.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

1. This schedule applies only where consumers have installed and use cooking and heating appliances other than lamp socket devices of at least 2 kilowatt capacity.

2. Bathrooms, halls and cellars are not classified as active rooms.

3. The active connected cooking and heating load shall be taken as 100% of the first 2 k.w. installed and 50% of the connected load installed in excess of 2 k.w. computed to the nearest one-tenth of a kilowatt but is never to be taken as less than 2 k.w. Instantaneous water heaters will be rated as 100% active connected load. Where the connected load is so arranged that all of it cannot be connected at one time, only the maximum load that can be connected will be used as a basis for the active load.

4. Combination service is not rendered for residences of over eight rooms.

The above schedule of rates shall be applicable to the service as set forth based upon all regular meter readings taken on and after July 10, 1920.
