The Imperial Ice and Development Company, a corporation, having, on July 22, 1920, filed with the Commission an application for an amendment to General Order No. 26 so as to authorize a clearance in certain cases different from that specified by the original terms of the Order, and the same having been disposed of informally by granting the applicant permission to construct its platforms with an impaired clearance of six feet eight inches (6'8") instead of eight feet six inches (8'6") when the consent of the interested railroad company has been secured,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That the application in the above entitled matter be, and the same is hereby dismissed.
