SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

WHEREAS, this Commission in its Decision No.7983
in Application No.5728, dated August 17, 1920, authorized
certain common carriers to increase passenger fares!

And whereas, carriers have by tariff publications
restricted the use of commutation tickets having longer
limit than calendar month, or exceeding thirty five (35) days
from date of sale; and

It appearing that such restrictions are not in har-
mony with the order in this application and not just to the
traveling public,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the tariffs of the car-
riers be amended to provide that "All commutation or other
multiple forms of tickets having longer limits than calendar
month or exceeding thirty five (35) days from date of sale,
sold prior to August 26, 1920, will be honored within their
limits."
