O R D E R .

WHEREAS, the above named Ocean Shore Railroad Company filed herein its application for leave to discontinue service and abandon its line; and

WHEREAS, pending the hearing of said application said Company has discontinued service over its said line; and

WHEREAS, said Company urges as a reason and necessity for such discontinuance that practically all of its operating force has quit its employ; and

WHEREAS, said Company has been negotiating with the governmental authorities of the City and County of San Francisco with a view to effecting some method by which switching service may be resumed and continued pending the order of this Commission to be made in the above entitled matter, which said negotiations have re-

sulted in the execution of an agreement between the said City and County of San Francisco and the said Ocean Shore Railroad Company, ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ which said agreement has been filed herein and is hereby referred to; and

WHEREAS, it appears to this Commission that by the terms of said agreement, the said Company may and will be permitted to continue its said switching service through the agency and with the aid of said City and County of San Francisco for an during the time in said agreement designated; and

WHEREAS, said agreement was made subject to the approval of this Commission,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said agreement be and is hereby approved; provided, however, that this approval shall not be considered in any degree as any release from, modification in, or change of the legal obligation of said Ocean Shore Railroad Company to the public until further order of this Commission; and, provided further, that the approval herein given of said agreement is for the purpose of enabling said Company to resume and maintain its switching operations only, and an approval in so far as this Commission has jurisdiction under the terms of the Public Utilities Act, and is not intended as an approval of said agreement as to such other legal requirements to which said agreement may be subject.
