ORDER

Western Motor Transport Company, a corporation, and
O. L. Swett and Jose Figueroa have made application petitioning
the Railroad Commission for authority to transfer certain op-
erative rights and privileges for the conduct of an automobile
passenger service between Tracy and Los Banos, California, the
applicants Swett and Figueroa desiring to sell and the appli-
cant Western Motor Transport Company desiring to purchase,
acquire and hereafter operate said service.

The rights and privileges proposed to be transferred
are those acquired by the applicants O. L. Swett and Jose
Figueroa by reason of a certificate of public convenience and
necessity having been granted by the Railroad Commission in

its Decision No. 6662, Application No. 4918, decided September 12, 1919, the transfer of the rights and privileges herein proposed to be made in accordance with the agreement accompanying the application in this proceeding.

The Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary, and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. That the applicants, O. L. Swett and Jose Figeroa will be required to immediately cancel all tariff rates, fares and charges and time schedules on file with the Railroad Commission in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

2. That the applicant, Western Motor Transport Company, a corporation, will be required to file tariff of fares and charges and a time schedule in their own name, or to adopt as their own the tariffs and time schedules as heretofore filed by applicants O. L. Swett and Jose Figeroa, all rates to be identical with those heretofore filed by applicants O. L. Swett and Jose Figeroa.

3. The rights and privileges, transfer of which are hereby authorized, may not again be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned, unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or

assignment has first been secured.

4. No vehicle may be operated under this authority for transfer by applicant Western Motor Transport Company unless such vehicle is owned by them or is leased by them under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
