ORDER AUTHORIZING TRANSFER.

L public hearing upon above application having been held in Los Angeles by Examiner Westover, at Which a basis for agreement was reached by the parties, and since the hearing the protest against permitting the transfer having been withdrawn in writing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that F. R. Watson, Sr. be and he is hereby authorized to transfer to Mutual Trucking and Transportation Corporation his operative rights relating to freight and express transportation between Los Angeles, Venice, Ocean Park, Santa Monica and way stations heretofore conducted under the name of Watson's Venice Transfer and

Watson's Venice of America Transfer Company or F. R. Watson, Sr., said rights having been acquired by operation prior to May 1, 1917.

The authority hereby granted is subject to the following conditions:

- I. That applicant Mutual Trucking and Transportation Corporation will within 20 days from the date hereof file with the Railroad Commission written acceptance of this order, subject to the conditions imposed herein.
- 2. That said applicant, F. R. Watson, Sr. cancel his tariff on file with the Railroad Commission in accordance with General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.
- J. That said Mutual Trucking and Transportation Corporation immediately file with the Railroad
 Commission its tariff or adopt as its own the tariff heretofore filed by said Watson, such fares and charges to be identical with those heretofore filed by said Watson.
- 4. The rights and privileges of transfer hereby authorized may not again be sold, leased, transferred, discontinued nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such sale, lease, transfer, discontinuance or assignment has first been secured.
- 5. No vehicle may be operated under this authority for transfer by applicant, F. R. Watson, unless such vehicle is owned by him or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
