Jack Keith and M. H. Waterman have made application to the Railroad Commission petitioning for authority to conduct automobile passenger stage service between San Jose and California Redwood Park, otherwise known as Big Basin.

The applicant Keith being the present holder of the operative rights desires to sell one half interest to applicant Waterman and to continue operation of the line as a co-partnership. The operative rights herein sought to be transferred are those acquired by the applicant Keith by Decision No.7513 in Application No.5607 dated April 1920, the transfer of operative rights herein authorized to be made upon an agreement shown in the application in this proceeding.

The Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

lst- That the applicants, Jack Keith and M. H. Waterman will within twenty (20) days from the date hereof file with the Railroad Commission a written acceptance of the order in this proceeding, subject to the conditionsimposed herein. 2nd- That the applicant, Waterman, will be required to immediately file with the Railroad Commission his tariff of fares and a time schedule, or will adopt as his own the tariff and time schedule heretofore filed by applicant Jack Keith, such fares, charges and time schedule to be identical with those heretofore filed by the applicant Jack Keith.

3rd- The rights and privileges of transfer hereby authorized may not again be sold, leased, transferred, discontinued nor assigned, unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such sale, lease, transfer, discontinuance or assignment has first been secured.

4th- That no vehicle may be operated by the applicants, Jack Keith and M. H. Waterman, unless such vehicle is owned by them or is leased by them for a specified amount on a trip or term basis, the leasing of equipment not to include the services of a driver or operator. All employment of drivers or operators of leased cars shall be made on the basis of a contract by which the driver or operator shall bear the relation of an employee to the transportation company by whom such driver or operator is engaged.
