SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER AND ORDER DENYING
PETITION FOR REHEARING.

The Railroad Commission having on July 15, 1920, issued its order (Decision No. 7880), in the above entitled matter, wherein certain flat rates were established for the sale of water by North Moneta Garden Lands Water Company, and subsequently, applicant having applied for a supplemental order establishing meter rates, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a further hearing is necessary and that meter rates should be established,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that North Moneta Garden Lands Company be and it is hereby authorized to file with the Railroad Commission within twenty (20) days from the date of this order, and thereafter charge the following schedule of meter rates, said schedule to be supplemental to the rates established in Decision No. 7880 in the above entitled proceeding:

DOMESTIC METER RATES:

For 400 cu.ft. of water, or less,	\$1.00
From 400 cu.ft. to 1000 cu.ft., per 100 c.f.,	.20
From 1000 " " to 2000 " " " 100 " "	.15
All in excess of 200 cu.ft., per 100 c.f.,	.12

Note:-

Meters may be installed at the option of the consumer or the company. When a meter is installed at the request of a consumer, a deposit may be required, such deposit to be returned to the consumer as a credit on monthly water bills at a rate of one-twentieth (1/20) of the deposit per month.

The following deposits may be required:

For 5/8" meter,	\$15.00
" 3/4" "	20.00
" 1" "	25.00
" 1-1/2" "	45.00
" 2" "	70.00

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 7880 heretofore rendered in this matter shall be and remain in full force and effect, this order being supplemental thereto and in no wise a modification thereof.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that applicant's petition for rehearing in this matter be, and it is hereby denied.
