ORDER

Ernest Crabb and Everett Morgan and J. O. Hagan have made application petitioning the Railroad Commission for authority to transfer certain operative rights for the conduct of an automobile passenger and freight service between Fresno and Kingsburg via Fowler & Selma. Ernest Crabb and Everett C. Morgan desiring to purchase, acquire and hereafter operate said line.

The rights and privileges hereby authorized to be transferred are those acquired by applicant J. O. Hagan by reason of his operation of the stage line on May 1, 1917, and continuously operating same since that date.

The transfer of the rights and privileges is to be made in accordance with a memorandum agreement, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part of the application in this proceeding.

The Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted subject to the following conditions:

1. That the applicant, J. O. Hagan, will be required to immediately cancel his tariff of fares, rules and regulations and time schedule on file with the Railroad Commission, in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51, and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

2. That applicants Ernest Crabb and Everett C. Morgan will be required to file tariff of fares, rules and regulations and a time schedule in their own names, or to adopt as their own the tariff and time schedule as heretofore filed by applicant, J. O. Hagan, all fares, rules and regulations and time schedule to be identical with those filed by applicant J. O. Hagan.

3. That the rights and privileges of transfer hereby authorized may not be sold, leased, discontinued, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such sale, lease, discontinuance, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

4. That no vehicle may be operated under this authority for transfer by applicants, Ernest Crabb and Everett C. Morgan, unless such vehicle is owned by them or is leased by them under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
