BY THE COMMISSION -

O R D E R

E. G. Rice, operating under the fictitious name of "Rice Auto Delivery" and G. R. Cleaveland have applied to the Railroad Commission of the State of California for an order authorizing the sale and transfer of an auto truck line as a common carrier of freight from applicant E. G. Rice to applicant G. R. Cleaveland.

The proposed sale and transfer is to be made in accordance with memorandum agreement accompanying the application in this proceeding.

The rights and privileges proposed to be transferred are those acquired by applicant, E. G. Rice, by virtue of his having operated the service prior to May 1, 1917, and in good faith having continuously operated since that date.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted, subject to the following conditions:

1- That the applicants, E. G. Rice and G. R. Cleaveland will immediately file with the Railroad Commission the original or a certified copy of the bill of sale.

2- That the applicant E. G. Rice will be required to immediately cancel his tariff of rates, rules and regulations on file with the Railroad Commission, in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3- That the applicant G. R. Cleaveland will be required to file tariff of rates, rules and regulations in his own name or to adopt as his own the tariff hereto filed by applicant, E. G. Rice, all rates, rules and regulations to be identical with those filed by applicant E. G. Rice.

4- The rights and privileges of transfer hereby authorized may not again be sold, leased, discontinued, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such sale, lease, discontinuance, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

5- No vehicle may be operated under this authority for transfer by applicant G. R. Cleaveland, unless such vehicle is owned by him or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
