V. C. Gorst, H. N. Richards, and H. W. Lowell, co-partners, operating under the fictitious name of Vallejo Bus Company, have made application petitioning the Railroad Commission to grant them authority to discontinue their automotive passenger stage service between Vallejo and Morrow Cove, Solano County.

This bus line has made a sworn statement that its passenger operating income for the months of June and July was \$15.17 daily while its operating cost for the same period was \$23.40 a day.

It was originally anticipated that there would be considerable passenger business handlod in connection with the Six Minute Ferry, from Crockett to Vallejo, but this has failed to materialize. The Bay Shore Stage Company, having operative rights from Crockett to Vallejo, is carrying practically all passengers over that route.

The Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that this application should be granted. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same is hereby granted.
