FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Pacific Gas and Electric Company having filed with the Railroad Commission a stipulation, in which Pacific Gas and Electric Company agrees that it will never claim before the Bailroad Commission, or any court or other public body, a value for the rights and privileges secured under Ordinance No. 103 of the County of Yolo in excess of the actual cost, which cost is reported at \$305.50, and said stipulation being in satisfactory form, and

Pacific Gas and Electric Company having filed with the Railroad Commission a certified copy of Ordinance No. 23 of the City of Davis, duly adopted by the Board of Trustees of the said City of Davis on August 23, 1920, wherein and whereby Pacific Gas and Electric Company, its successors and assigns, is granted for a term of firty years the right, privilege and franchises of laying, maintaining and using gas pipes in the public streets and highways of the said wity of Davis, which Ordinance by its terms became effective on or about September 22, 1920, and is in form satisfactory to this Commission, and

Pacific Gas and Electric Company having filed with the Railroad Commission a stipulation in which Pacific Gas and Electric Company agrees that it will never claim before the Railroad Commission, or any court or other public body, a value for the rights and privileges secured under Ordinance No. 23 of the City of Davis in excess of the actual cost, which cost is reported at \$237.00, and said stipulation being in satisfactory form,

NOW, THEREFORE, Railroad Commission of the State of California hereby declares that public convenience and necessity require and will require the exercise by Pacific Gas and Electric Company the rights and privileges conferred by Ordinance No. 103 of the County of Yolo, passed and approved on July 12, 1920 by the Board of Supervisors of the said County of Yolo, and by Ordinance No. 23 of the City of Davis, passed and approved on August 23, 1920 by the Board of Trustees of the said City of Davis.
