SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

J. Boshoff, to whom was issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automotive passenger stage service between Santa Rosa and Jenner-by-the-Sea, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for authority to discontinue his service until May 15, 1921, for the following reasons:

That between Monte Rio and Jenner-by-the-Sea travel is only during the summer season and now that the vacation period is over this traffic has ceased; and between Monte Ric and Santa Rosa on account of the highway being torn up for repairs and the roads practically impassable, making operation dangerous.

Good cause appearing, and the Commission being fully

advised believes this application should be and the same is hereby granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that J. Boshoff be permitted to discontinue the service now rendered by him between Santa Rosa and Jenner-by-the-Sea until May 15, 1921.
