

forth in the application of this proceeding.

The Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. That applicants, C. E. Garner and Wm. Harper and M. C. Duncan will within twenty (20) days from date of this order file with the Railroad Commission a written acceptance of this Order.

2. That the applicant, C. E. Garner, will be required to immediately cancel all tariffs of rates, charges and time schedule on file with the Railroad Commission in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3. That applicants, Wm. Harper and M. C. Duncan will be required to file tariff of rates and charges and a time schedule in their own name or to adopt as their own the tariffs and time schedules as heretofore filed by applicant, C. E. Garner, all rates to be identical with those filed by applicant, C. E. Garner.

4. The rights and privileges of transfer which are hereby authorized may not again be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

5. No vehicle may be operated under this authority for transfer by applicants Wm. Harper and M. C. Duncan unless such vehicle is owned by them or is leased by

them under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory
to the Railroad Commission.
