O R D E R

Nicholas P. Sinnott has made application to the Railroad Commission petitioning for certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automotive passenger, freight, baggage and express service between the town of Felton and Felton Station on the Southern Pacific Company's rails in Santa Cruz County.

The Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that public convenience and necessity require Nicholas P. Sinnott to establish an automotive passenger, freight, baggage and express service between the town of Felton and Felton Station on the Southern Pacific Company's rails in Santa Cruz County and that a certificate of public convenience and necessity should be and the same is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1st- That the applicant, Nicholas P. Sinnott, will within twenty (20) days from the date of this order file with the Railroad Commission a written acceptance of the same, subject to the conditions imposed herein and will, within ninety (90) days, commence operation of the service requested.

2nd- That the applicant, Nicholas P. Sinnott, will be required to immediately file a tariff of fares, charges and a time schedule, in duplicate, with the Railroad Commission, in accordance with General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3rd- The rights and privileges herein authorized may not be sold, leased, transferred, discontinued nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such sale, lease, transfer, discontinuance or assignment has first been secured.

4th- No vehicle may be operated by the applicant, Nicholas P. Sinnott, unless such vehicle is owned by him or is leased by him for a specific amount on a trip or term basis, the leasing of equipment not to include the services of a driver or operator. All employment of drivers or operators of leased cars shall be made on the basis of a contract by which the driver or operator shall bear the relation of an employee to the transportation company by whom such driver or operator is engaged.
