BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

United Stages, Inc., a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for authority to discontinue its service and cancel its time schedules and tariffs between Los Angeles and San Diego via Whittier Road and via Telegraph Road alleging that the facilities of the Motor Transit Company and the Pickwick Stages, Inc., are adequate to satisfactorily handle the traffic offering for movement by automobile stage between Los Angeles and San Diego over the routes herein sought to be abandoned.

Applicant claims operative routes between Los Angeles and San Diego as follows:

- "Los Angeles to San Diego via Whittier, Fullerton, Anaheim, and Santa Ana;
- Los Angeles to San Diego via Telegraph Road, Norwalk, La Mirada, Buena Park, Anaheim and Santa Ana;
- Los Angeles to San Diego via Huntington Park, Long Beach Boulevard, Long Beach, Seal Beach, Westminster and Santa Ana; said three above described routes converging at Santa Ana; and thence to San Diego via Capistrano, Oceanside, La Jolla."

The effect of the granting of this application is to eliminate the service of the applicant in the territory between Los Angeles and Santa Ana via Whittier and via Telegraph Road and, inasmuch as the competing lines have assented to the granting of this application as evidenced by exhibits attached to the application in this proceeding, the Commission is of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted and that the operation between Los Angeles and Santa Ana via Whittier and via Telegraph Road may be suspended upon five days notice to the travelling public by posting at the terminals at Los Angeles and Santa Ana and at all stations intermediate to such terminals where ticket agencies are maintained by the applicant; provided, further, that tariffs and schedules covering operation between Los Angeles and Santa Ana will be cancelled in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51.

This order, authorizing cancellation of schedules, tariffs and operation over the routes between Los Angeles and Santa Ana via Whittier and via Telegraph Road shall not be construed to affect or establish any routes claimed by applicant, United Stages, Inc., for operation between Los Angeles and San Diego, via Long Beach, the status of such operation now being the subject of inquiry by the Commission in Case Number 1473.
