O R D E R

J. H. Moore and R. W. Barnett, owning and operating a telephone line extending from Ione, Amador County, to Wallace, Calaveras County, having asked for authority, on the part of J. H. Moore to sell and transfer, and on the part of R. W. Barnett to purchase, an undivided one-half interest in said telephone line for the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), the property to be transferred being described as follows:

An undivided one-half interest in a single line, grounded circuit, erected on fence posts and trees, and consisting of 25 or 30 miles of wire and 23 telephones, more or less.

And it appearing to the Railroad Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application herein be and the same hereby is granted; provided, that the consideration given for the property authorized to be transferred shall not be taken before this Commission, or any other body, as representing for rate

fixing or other purposes the value of the property transferred;
and provided further that the authority herein granted shall
apply only to such transfer as is made on or before December 31,
1920.
