FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

An ex parte order was issued in this proceeding,
Decision No. 8257, rendered October 16, 1920, granting authority
to applicant, C. E. Garner, to transfer to Wm. Harper and M.O.Duncan.
At the time the ex parte order was issued the fact was inadvertently
overlooked that a complaint had been filed by E. B. Overholtzer and
E. S. Garfield against the applicant Garner, in which was taken up
the validity of the operating rights of Garner, who had previously
secured alleged operative rights from Wm. Harper, one of the
applicants in this proceeding.

The Commission, therefore, rescinds its authority
granted in Decision No. 8257 on Application No. 6181, pending a

decision in Case No. 1483, Overholtzer and Garfield vs Garner, hearing set before Examiner Westover at Lancaster on November 10, 1920. Good cause appearing and the Commission being fully advised,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the authority granted in Decision No. 8257, October 16, 1920, on Application No. 6181, be and the same is hereby rescinded.
