FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS, Decision Number 8050 on the above entitled application as decided September 1, 1920, required applicants to file an acceptance of the certificate granted between Santa Cruz and Monterey and intermediate points, such acceptance to state the date upon which the operation authorized by the decision would be commenced (such date to be not less than thirty days from the date of the acceptance specified in the order) and,

WHEREAS, request has been received that an extension of the date for the commencement of operation be made to and including November 15, 1920, and,

WHEREAS, the Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not required and that the application should be granted.
