

serve a road building camp, two mining camps and a few ranchers, all of whom buy their supplies in Weaverville and must travel there to connect with the stage for Redding on the Southern Pacific lines.

The proposed route is 18 miles over a very mountainous country. Applicant has the contract to carry the U. S. mail for a term of four years beginning July 1, 1918, since which time he has also been carrying passengers and freight and some express parcels in addition to goods shipped by parcel post in ignorance of the requirement of the law that he should receive a certificate from the Commission. There is no other means of transportation between the points in question.

O R D E R

A public hearing having been held upon the above described application, the matter being now submitted and ready for decision,

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by applicant W. A. Goetze of automotive or horse drawn vehicles as a common carrier of freight and passengers between Weaverville, Junction City and Helena, all in Trinity County.

The rights and privileges acquired hereby may not be transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been procured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated in said service unless said vehicle is owned by

the applicant herein or is leased by said applicant under a contract or agreement satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the said applicant shall, within 10 days from the date hereof file with the Railroad Commission his schedule and tariffs covering said proposed service, and shall set forth the date upon which the operation of the line hereby authorized will commence, which date shall be within 90 days from date hereof, unless time to begin operation is extended by formal supplemental order.

The authority herein contained shall not become effective until and unless the above mentioned schedule and tariff are filed within the time herein limited.
