In the matter of the application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the removal of its station at Broadway, Burlingame, San Mateo County, California.

ORDER

November 12, 1920 filed with the Commission an application for permission to move its station building at Broadway, Burlingame, San Matec County, from the present location on the easterly side of its tracks to a point nearly opposite on the westerly side of its tracks, as hereinafter indicated, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary; that the City of Burlingame favors the moving of the station building as indicated; that the moving of the building will be in the interest of public convenience and safety, and it further appearing that this application should be granted.

IT IS HERRESY ORDERED. That permission be hereby granted Southern Pacific Company to move its station building at Broadway. Burlingame, San Mateo County, from the present location on the easterly side of its tracks, to a point on the westerly side of its tracks, nearly opposite the present location.

all of the above as shown by the map attached to the application, and subject to the following conditions, viz:

- (1) The expense of moving the depot shall be borne in such manner as the applicant and the City of Burlingame may agree. Copy of agreement shall be filed with this Commission within thirty (30) days after execution.
- (2) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the location, operation, and maintenance of this station building as to it may seem right and proper, and to revoke the permission herein granted, if in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.
