O P I N I O N

At a public hearing upon the above application held at Los Angeles, the evidence showed that applicant serves three patrons with irrigation water for 25 acres of land and two of them with domestic water from his well located on his ranch about two miles northwest of Garden Grove, Orange County.

One of these patrons has a pumping plant, irrigating about 200 acres, from which he will also irrigate his 5 acres previously irrigated from applicant's well. Another plans to install pumping plant upon his own ranch, and the third has leased his ranch to a tenant who has also leased applicant's ranch and plans to irrigate both properties from applicant's plant. Each of the three patrons have signed a document releasing applicant from further obligation to serve on and after January 1, 1921.

O R D E R

A public hearing having been held upon the above application, the matter being submitted and now ready for decision,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant F. W. Crouch be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to discontinue public service of water for irrigation and domestic purposes from his plant hereinabove described, on and after January 1, 1921.
