O R D E R

Sarop Mektaroff and Joe Bozoff have petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order approving the transfer of the operative rights on an automobile truck milk route operating as a common carrier of milk, between Los Angeles and Strawberry park, Gardena and Moneta (East Side), applicant, Sarop Mektaroff desiring to sell and transfer his one-half interest in such truck line, and applicant, Joe Bozoff, desiring to purchase and acquire the one-half interest in the ownership and operation of said truck line.

The conditions under which the proposed transfer is to be made are incorporated in the application in this proceeding, and the rights and privileges now held by applicants Serap Mektaroff and Joe Bozoff, are those obtained by reaosn of a certificate of transfer having been granted by the Railroad Commission in Decision

No. 7429, Application No. 5502 decided April 15, 1920.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be, and the same hereby is, granted subject to the following conditions:

1. That the amount paid for the purchase of this property shall not be considered as a measure of value of said property before this commission for rate fixing or any other purpose other than the transfer herein referred to.
2. That the applicant, Sarop Mektaroff will be required to immediately cancel all tariffs now filed with the Railroad Commission in the name of Mektaroff and Bozoff, such cancellation to be made in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.
3. That applicant, Joe Bozoff, will be required to immediately file tariffs in his own name or to adopt as his own the tariffs as heretofore filed with the Railroad Commission by applicants, Sarop Mektaroff and Joe Bozoff, all fares to be identical with those filed by applicants, Sarop Mektaroff and Joe Bozoff.
4. The rights and privileges of transfer which are hereby authorized, may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned, unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such
