SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that that portion of the Commission's Order, Decision No. 7928, issued January 29, 1920, in the above entitled proceeding, which relates to the filing of rates, be and it is hereby amended and changed to read as follows:

"IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Conservative Investment Company be and it is hereby authorized and directed to file with the Railroad Commission on or before March 1, 1921, and thereafter charge the following rates for water delivered to consumers in Neff Station Acres:

METERED SERVICE

Minimum monthly payment, entitling consumer to 500 cubic feet-----	\$ 1.50
From 500 to 1000 cubic feet, per 100 cubic feet-----	.20
Over 1000 cubic feet, per 100 cubic feet-----	.15
Fire Hydrants per year per outlet-----	12.00"

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects Decision No. 7928 in the above entitled proceeding shall be and remain in full force and effect.
