FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, on November 27, 1920, the Railroad Commission issued its order approving a wharf franchise obtained by the Petroleum Products Company from the Board of Supervisors of the County of Contra Costa, which order provided in part that it would not become effective until applicant had filed with this Commission a stipulation to the effect that it would not claim a value for such franchise in excess of the actual cost thereof, and

WHEREAS, a stipulation has been filed by applicant to the effect that neither applicant, its successors or assigns will ever claim before the RAILROAD COMMISSION or any other rate fixing body, a value for such franchise in excess of the actual cost of procuring the same which was the sum of \$400.00. .
