ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Napa Milling Company, a warehouse utility, having applied to this Commission for authority to increase rates for storing and handling grain and wool in its warehouses located at Napa; and having, by reason of alleged inability to segregate its expense accounts, failed to supply essential information and data; and the Commission believing that such failure to furnish material facts constitutes grounds for dismissal of the application,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the application of Napa Milling Company for authority to increase rates for storing and handling grain and wool be and the same is hereby dismissed, without prejudice.
