ORDER OF DISMISSAL

J. Scott, doing business under the fictitious name of Kings River Transportation Company, and now operating an automotive freight and passenger service as a common carrier between the city of Fresno and San Joaquin Light & Power Company Camp No.2, Fresno County, and intermediate points, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for authority to detour from his present route at a point on Ventura Avenue, corner of Academy Road, thence south to the town of Sanger,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  miles, and return, for the purpose of carrying U.S. mail between Sanger and points along the route of the Kings River Transportation Company.

The Railroad Commission has no jurisdiction over the handling of U. S. mail and inasmuch as this application was made

entirely for the purpose of handling mail, the Commission believes the application should be dismissed. Good cause appearing and the Commission being fully advised.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same is hereby dismissed.
