OPINION ON PETITION FOR REHEARING

This is an application by the Pacific Rice Growers Association for a rehearing of Case No. 1432, decided by the Commission on January 6, 1921, Decision No. 8517. The petition refers to a number of matters to which we gave careful consideration.

The same decision covered Case No. 1437, Rosenberg Bros. & Company and other Rice Milling Companies, wherein a somewhat similar

complaint was made to that presented to the Commission in Case No. 1432. There has been no petition for a rehearing submitted in Case No. 1437.

After careful consideration of the petition herein, prompted by a desire to do justice to all parties concerned, we find no good reason for granting a rehearing. The petition must be denied.
