ORDER

By the Commission.

SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY, a corporation, having on August 12, 1913, filed with the Commission an application for permission to construct a connection track at grade across Fox Street, City of Lemoore, Kings County, California, as hereinafter indicated, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary, that Board of Trustees of said City of Lemoore has granted a franchise or permit for the construction of said track at grade; and it further appearing that it is not reasonable nor practicable to avoid a grade crossing with said Fox Street, and that the application should be granted subject to the conditions hereinafter specified,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be hereby granted Southern Pacific Company to construct a connection track at grade across Fox Street in the City of Lemoore, Kings County, California, on the north side of its main line between Hill Street and Heinlen Street, to serve the plant of Lemoore Lumber Company, as shown by the map attached to the application and subject to the following conditions, viz.:

(1) The entire expense of constructing the crossing together with the cost of its maintenance hereafter in good and first-class condition for the safe and convenient use of the public shall be borne by applicant.

(2) Applicant shall provide the necessary plank or guard rails for the construction of said crossing, and shall construct same of a width not less than twenty-four (24) feet, with grades of approach not
