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The applicant, E. J. Ellison, has, on March Eth, 1921, made application petitioning the Railroad Commission fox a certificate of pubic convenience and necessity to operate an automobile passenger service as a common carrier of passengers, between points located beyond the city limits of Modesto and points within the said city of Moiesto, over a route hereinafter described.

The service proposed by applicant is in the nature of a bus service sexting the city of Modesto and a new addition located ontefde said City; also for the accommodation of high school children living th said addition, who now have no means of transportation.
applicant proposes to charge a pare of ten cents from and to all points and to operate at present on a two how r schedule between tie hours of 8 A. IF. end 8 ?. Kr., using as equipment two sixteen passenger Fora Trucks, and one sixteen Ford Track held in reserve.

The route over which epplicant proposes to traverse is as follows: Begiming at the intorsection of paradise Road and I Street, approximately one hmdred feet onteide the City Ifants of Modesto, thence out E. Street to Menth Street, thence over menth. Street to J. Street, thence over J. Street to the intersection of J Street ond riczenery Street, thence over NeEenery Stieet to a point Iocated one-haie mile outside the city Ifmits OU Modesto, and withfn new addition afore mentioned.

The commesion is of the opinion thet this is a matter in which a pribic heering is not necessery and that the applicatfou showle be granted.

IT IS HEREBY DECLSFED thet prblic convenfence and nacesaity require the establishment by $\overline{\text { n }}$. J. EIIIson of an antom mobile passonger service between a point located on Mrezenery Street one-half mile outside the city of krodesto in the nor adidtion sitasted north of seid City of xodesto, to a point on reEnaery Street where the ropte enters the City of modesto, and betmeen a point on E Street where roate Leaves the City Ifmits of Mofeato to a point lemomil as paradise Road and I Street, appraximately one hmarod feet outside the city limits of the city of modeato over route herefrbefore described, and thet a certiticete of public convenfence and necessity shome ber, and the same hereby is granted, sabject to the followiag conditionse
I. Thet applicent, E. J. ElIisoc, will, within twenty (20) dajs from the date hereof, IIIe With the Railroad Comission his written acceptance of this certificete añ the conditions named herejn, and that seid applicent Will comence this service within pinety (90) days from the dete hereof.
2. That appIicant, 玉. J. EIIIson, TIII be fmmediately reqrired to ifle tarifi of fores, rales and regulations anc time schedale with the Rafirosd Comisesion in accordance with provisions of General Order NO. $5 I$ and other regalations 0 the Reflroed Comiseion.
3. That the operative rights and privileges, authority for which is hereby granted, may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned ties the written consent of the Railroad commission to such discontinuance, sale. lease, transfer or assignment has fret been secured.
4. No vericie meg be operated by the applicant, E. J. EllIson, mils such vehicle is omer by him or is leased by him for a specilited amomt on a win or term basis, the Leasing of equipment not to include the services of a driver or operator. EII employment of drivers or operators of leased cars shall be
 driver or operator shall boar the relation of an ompiojee to tho transportextion company.
