OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY.

By this Commission's Decision No. 7941, August 2, 1920,
R.E.Murray and E.G.Wilson were granted authority to operate an
automotive transportation service for hauling milk between Dixon
and San Francisco.

Applicants in this proceeding having discontinued oper-
ation without permission from the Railroad Commission it is our
opinion that their certificate should be revoked. Good cause appear-

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that revocation of the certificate of
public convenience and necessity granted to R.E.Murray and E.G.Wilson
become effective at once.
