O P I N I O N

Under date of April 25, 1913, the Railroad Commission
of the State of California, after a regular hearing, rendered its
Opinion and Order "in the matter of the rates and service of San
Gorgonio Water Company and the Beaumont Land and Water Company".

On May 5th, an application for rehearing was filed with
this Commission by the San Gorgonio Water Company and the Beaumont
Land and Water Company, which application was set down for argu-
ment, and argument regularly heard on June 13th.

It is not considered necessary at this time to refer in
detail to the reasons advanced as justifying this application for
a rehearing. We regard it as sufficient to say that, after due
consideration has been given to the application and the reasons
for making the same, we are of the opinion that, to avoid all pos-
sibility of a miscarriage of justice, it is our duty to grant the
application for rehearing to the end that matters and things which
were not presented at the former hearing may be placed before the
Commission and a conclusion arrived at after all parties in inter-
est have again been given an opportunity to exhaustively present
to the Commission the merits of their contention.

We recommend the following Order:-

O R D E R

WHEREAS, on April 25, 1913, this Commission rendered its Opinion and Order in Case No. 308, being the case of the Commission's investigation on its own initiative of the rates and practices of the San Geronio Water Company and the Beaumont Land and Water Company; and

WHEREAS, on May 5th, said San Geronio Water Company and said Beaumont Land and Water Company applied for a rehearing of said case; and

WHEREAS, the reasons set forth for and the allegations made in support of the application for rehearing have satisfied this Commission that such application should be granted;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the application for a rehearing of the above entitled case be and it hereby is granted, and that the case upon rehearing be set down for trial at San Bernardino, California, and that all parties interested be notified of the granting of the application for rehearing and of the time at which the case will be heard.

The foregoing Opinion and Order are hereby approved and ordered filed as the Opinion and Order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California.
