FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Decision No. 8725, heretofore rendered in this proceeding under date of March 10, 1921, contained a typographical error in that a declaration was made eliminating the carrying of local passengers between Saratoga and Big Basin, and whereas such decision should have authorized the carrying of local passengers between Saratoga and Big Basin,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the declaration contained in paragraph three (3) of this decision, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3. THAT applicant, E. A. Cross, will not be permitted to carry local passengers between San Jose and Saratoga, nor between any of the

intermediate points between San Jose and Saratoga, but will confine his business to carrying through passengers to and from Big Basin (California Redwood Park).
