O R D E R

In the above entitled proceeding Elroy M. Johnson makes application for authority to transfer to John E. Scarborough a small domestic water system known as the Flora Water Company, supplying some eighteen consumers at Perry Station on the Pacific Electric Railway, Los Angeles County, more particularly described in the application, as follows:

"the property known as the East 108 feet of Lot 1 La Fresa Tract, in Los Angeles recorded in Book 6, page 54 of Maps of said County, with the irrigation system thereon, and all the pipe lines, meters, etc., appurtenant thereto, and which are used or may be used in the supplying of water to the various users."

The said John E. Scarborough having joined in the application, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Elroy M. Johnson be and he is hereby authorized to transfer the above described Flora Water Company to the said John E. Scarborough subject to the following conditions:

1. The authority herein granted will apply only to such transfer as may have been made on or before July 31, 1921, and a certified copy of conveyance shall be filed with the Commission by Elroy M. Johnson within thirty (50) days after the date on which it is ex-

ecuted.

2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which Elroy M. Johnson actually relinquishes control and possession of the properties herein authorized to be transferred, said Elroy M. Johnson shall file with the Railroad Commission certified statement indicating the date when such control and possession was relinquished.

3. The consideration given for the transfer of said public utility water property shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value of said properties for rate fixing for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
