THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good Cause Appearing Therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, pending the final submission and decision in the proceeding now before the Commission, entitled - "In the matter of the application of Great Western Power Company of California for an order authorizing increase in rates," Supplemental Application No. 5585, the Great Western Power Company of California be, and it is, authorized to charge and collect, in addition to its published rates and charges for electric service and in lieu of the present surcharge of 15%, a surcharge of 10% on all bills for metered service based on meter readings taken on and after April 10, 1921, and for flat rate service rendered after April 1, 1921.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that all sums collected upon said 10% surcharge shall be impounded by said utility, subject to the order of the Commission, in its final decision

in said proceeding, Supplemental Application No. 5585.
