SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, in this Commission's Decision No. 8755, dated March 15, 1921, Contra Costa Gas Company was authorized to charge and collect certain rates therein set forth for gas service rendered when said Company has obtained from this Commission a Supplemental Order finding that the quality of service rendered has been improved to comply with the standards prescribed by the Railroad Commission of the State of California, and

WHEREAS, the service conditions have been inspected and reported upon as being satisfactory by the Commission's engineers

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Contra Costa Gas Company be and the same is authorized to charge and collect for gas service rendered the rates authorized in Decision No. 8755 based on all regular meter readings after April 20, 1921.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Contra Costa Gas Company shall within ten days from the date of this order file with the Commission the schedule of rates herein established.
