SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

Good Cause Appearing:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the provision of Decision Number 8861 dated April 15, 1921, reading:-

That all the proceeds, except accrued interest, obtained from the sale of the bonds herein authorized, will be deposited with depositaries in accordance with the terms and provisions of the first mortgage executed by The Western Pacific Railroad Company, and expended only for such purposes as the Railroad Commission may hereafter authorize by supplemental order or orders. This order does not require applicant to deposit the accrued interest,

be, and it is hereby, amended so as to read-

That all the proceeds except accrued interest obtained from the sale of the bonds herein authorized will be deposited with depositaries in accordance with the terms and provisions of the First Mortgage executed by The Western Pacific Railroad Company, and expended only for such of the purposes specified in subsection A of Section 2 of Article Second of the said Mortgage as the Railroad Commission may hereafter authorize by supplemental order or orders. This order does not require applicant to deposit the accrued interest.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 8834 dated April 9, 1921, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Second Supplemental Order.
