ORDER

Written request has been made by applicant for authority to discontinue the operation of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between Bakersfield, California, and Oil Center, California, authorized by the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 8740 on Application No. 6561, decision dated March 14, 1921, for the alleged reason that the operation of the line is unprofitable. The cost of operation, far exceeding the revenue received, does not warrant a continuation of the business.

We are of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary in this matter, and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that this application be, and the same hereby is, granted.

The applicant will immediately cancel his tariff and time schedule, in accordance with the provisions of

General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad  
Commission.
