Opinion and Order the following language occurs:-


"That the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Com-

the rates now being charged to patrons at Portola
are satisfactory and no advance in said rates is
contemplated and no change other than the applica-
tion of the one-party rate explained above."

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That said language be changed
to read as follows:-

That the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Com-
pany file with this Commission a stipulation that
it will give good and efficient service to patrons
at Portola at its present rates with the addition
of the one-party rate explained above.

ordered filed as the Supplemental Order of the Railroad Commission
of the State of California.
