SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Written request having been made by attorney for applicant for authority to discontinue the operation of an automobile passenger service as a common carrier of passengers between Los Banos-Tracy and intermediate points, authorized by the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 8091 on Application No. 6051, Decision dated September 13, 1920, for the alleged reason that the expense of operation far exceeds the revenue received and does not warrant a continuation of the business.

The granting of this application will cause no inconvenience to the public, inasmuch as the route is now covered and we believe this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same is hereby granted.

This applicant will immediately cancel his tariffs and

time schedules in accordance with the provisions of General Order  
No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.
