SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WEEREAS this Commission, on the 23rd day of August 1920, issued its Decision No. 7987 authorizing Bay Point Light and Power Company to charge and collect in addition to its established rates for electric service a surcharge of 15% on all bills based on meter readings taken on and after August 24th, 1920 and before May 24th, 1921, unless otherwise ordered, and,

WHEREAS, Bay Point Light and Power Company has filed its supplemental application requesting authority to continue to charge and collect, after May 24th, 1921 and until otherwise ordered, the rates and surcharges authorized in said Decision No. 7987, or such other rates or charges as the Commission may hereafter authorize Great Western Power Company to charge and collect for similar service in the same territory, and,

WHEREAS. Bay Point Light and Power Company purchases

its entire supply of electric energy from Great Western Power Company and has heretofore paid for such electric energy at the schedule rates of Great Western Power Company and in addition thereto a surcharge of 15%, but effective April 10, 1921 said surcharge of 15% permitted to be collected by Great Western Power Company has been reduced to 10% by order of this Commission, thereby correspondingly reducing the cost to Bay Point Light and Power Company of electric energy purchased, and,

WEEREAS, this Commission is convinced of the propriety of a similar reduction in the rates to be charged and collected by Bay Point Light and Power Company for electric service supplied to its consumers, and,

WEEREAS, this order will result in a reduction of rates and, in the opinion of the Commission a public hearing is not necessary, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, pending further order of this Commission. Bay Point Light and Power Company be, and it is, authorized to charge and collect in addition to its published rates and charges for electric service, and in lieu of the present surcharge of 15%, a surcharge of 10% on all bills for metered service based on meter readings taken on and after May 24th, 1921.
