ORDER OF DENIAL OF PETITION
FOR REHEARING

WHEREAS, Coast Valleys Gas and Electric Company was authorized by the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 8937 in Application No. 6614, dated May 6th, 1921, to charge and collect certain rates for gas service; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pacific Grove, the City of Monterey and the City of Salinas, municipal corporations receiving gas service from the aforementioned corporation, have filed with this Commission a petition for rehearing of the above mentioned application alleging among other things, that since the time of the submission thereof, material reductions in the price of oil have occurred, rendering exorbitant, unjust and unreasonable the rates fixed by Decision No. 8937; and

WHEREAS, the basis for the request for rehearing set forth by petitioners is not sufficient legal grounds for the granting of a rehearing; and

WHEREAS, this Commission has, on its own motion, instituted proceedings - In the Matter of the Investigation of

the Gas Rates, Service and Operations of Coast Valleys Gas
and Electric Company,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition in the above
entitled application be, and the same is, hereby denied.
