SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

J. Boshoff to whom was issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automotive passenger stage service between Santa Rosa and Jenner-by-the-Sea, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order granting extension of the time to commence operations until June 15, 1921.

It is alleged that the highway over which service is to be performed is not in a passable condition.

In Decision No. 8255, rendered October 16, 1920, the Commission granted permission to discontinue operation of the service until May 15, 1921, for the reason that the vacation period being over the traffic had ceased, and on account of the highway between Monte Rio and Santa Rosa having been torn up for repairs the roads were practically impassable, making operation dangerous.
