ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Public hearings having been held upon the above entitled application at Los Molinos and later at San Francisco, at which it developed that the proposed point of grade crossing over three tracks in the yards of the Southern Pacific Company at Los Molinos involved considerable danger to the travelling public; and it being agreed by the parties at the hearing that the County and railroad officials would confer in reference to relocating the proposed road and point of crossing and report to the Commission; no such joint report having been made, but the Board of Supervisors having recently filed with the Commission a certified copy of its action adopting the report of a committee appointed by it to investigate and report to the Board, and report of said committee appearing to recommend the adoption

of a different route for the proposed road, which route would not involve a grade crossing over the railroad tracks near Los Molinos at this time, but appears to amount to an abandonment for the present of the original plan and application,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and it is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
