## ORDER

H. V. Freeman and A. J. Richardson have filed a joint application with the Railroad Commission in which they petition for an order authorizing the transfer of an automobile freight line at present operated by H. V. Freeman between Los Angeles, Montrose, La Crescenta, Tejunga and Sunland and intermediate points.

The agreement of sale provides for the transfer of the operative rights only for the sum of \$600.00.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY CRDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted subject to the following conditions:

l. That the sum to be paid for the operative rights shall not be urged as a measure of value for rate fixing or other purposes before this Commission or any other regulatory body.

- 2. That applicant H. V. Freeman will be required to immediately cancel all tariffs and time schedules now on file with the Railroad Commission, such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.
- 3. That applicant A. J. Richardson will be required to immediately file tariff and time schedule, in duplicate, in his own name, or to adopt as his own the tariffs and time schedules heretofore filed with the Railroad Commission by applicant H. V. Freeman, all rates to be identical with those filed by applicant H. V. Freeman.
- 4. That the rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale. lease, transfer, or assignment has first been secured.
- 5. That no vehicle may be operated by applicant a. J. Richardson, unless such vehicle is owned by him or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
