O R D E R

Huntington Beach Water Company, applicant herein, asks authority to transfer certain real property in the City of Huntington Beach, more particularly described in the application. The application states that applicant's consumers were formerly supplied from wells situated on the property in question, but that such wells have been condemned by the State Board of Health and therefore the property is no longer used or useful to applicant as public utility property. The applicant proposes to transfer this property to the Huntington Beach Company in even exchange for certain other property upon which applicant has developed new wells from which it intends to supply its consumers.

It appearing to the Commission that such property is not necessary or used or useful to the Huntington Beach Water Company in the discharge of its duties to the public, that a public hearing in this matter is not necessary, and that the application should be granted;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Huntington Beach Water Company be and it is hereby granted authority to dispose of that certain real property described in Appendix "A" and attached hereto and made

a part hereof.
