ORDER

In the above-entitled proceeding H. E. Hubbard, as
 Trustee, has applied to the Railroad Commission for permission
 to transfer the operative rights heretofore granted to C. W.
 Curphey, deceased, to operate an automobile freight line between
 Calipatria and Calexico, serving as intermediate points, El
 Centro, Brawley and Babar, to M. R. Downing as administrator
 of the estate of C. W. Curphey, deceased, and

It appearing to the Commission that this is a matter
 in which a formal hearing is not necessary and that the applica-
 tion should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-entitled application
 be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following
 conditions:

1. That applicant, H. E. Hubbard, shall immediately cancel all tariffs and time schedules filed under the name of C. W. Curphey, and applicant M. R. Downing, as administrator of the estate of C. W. Curphey, deceased, shall immediately file new tariffs and time schedules or adopt the tariffs and time schedules heretofore filed by C. W. Curphey, deceased.

2. That the rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

3. That no vehicle may be operated by M. R. Downing, as administrator of the Estate of C. W. Curphey, unless such vehicle is owned by the estate or is leased under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
