O R D E R

Edward T. Stoddard and C. J. Buchanan, Jr., were heretofore engaged in the operation of automobile passenger service between Fort Bragg and Cazadero in connection with their contract to carry United States Mail between such points. The mail contract having been let to another party, which party is engaged in serving the two points in question and there being no necessity for additional service, applicants have applied to the Commission for permission to discontinue operations,

It appearing to the Commission that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted subject to the following condition:

That the applicants immediately cancel
all tariffs of rates, fares and time schedules
at present filed with the Railroad Commission.
