O R D E R

B. P. McConnaha at present operating an automobile stage line between Orick and Orleans, both in the County of Humboldt, State of California, has filed with this Commission a petition in which he asks that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be issued authorizing him to extend such service, for the transportation of freight and passengers from Orleans, Humboldt County to Langford's Ranch in Siskiyou County, serving as an intermediate point County Line.

The applicant states that the road between the above named points has not as yet been finished, that there are a number of men still engaged in construction work and that neither they nor the ranchers and miners along such road have at the present time any means of transportation other than by private conveyance. He proposes to make three round trips per week between the above named points and to charge a passenger fare of \$1.25 per trip between Orleans and Langford's Ranch and \$1.00 per trip between County Line and Orleans and \$.25 per trip between County Line and Langford's Ranch. Applicant also proposes to handle freight at the rate of one-half cent per pound with a minimum charge of \$.25 on all packages handled.
