ORDER

In this proceeding Earl F. Blubaugh, operating under the fictitious name of Los Angeles-West Side Transportation Company, through his Agent, D. A. Monroe, has made application under Rules 10 and 11 of General Order No. 51 to establish on one day's notice certain rates, rules and regulations and classification, as set forth in Exhibits "A", "B", and "C", of the application.

The granting of this application will result in both increases and decreases in rates, reductions predominating. The increased rates apply on such articles as automobile bodies, chassis and auto seats, comparatively few of which are carried and which commodities are bulky as compared to their weight.

Letters from patrons of the applicant filed with the application were to the effect that if the adjustment applied for were established, these patrons would increase the amount of business shipped over applicant's line.

The Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that this application should be granted.
